



- Inverted pendants pivot forward and backward up to 30° allowing load to hang plumb
- Pendants allow free rotation to prevent chain assembly wear
- Adjustable and removable load centers on 6" increments
- Pivoting pendant prevents chain assembly wear, reducing maintenance and operational costs
- Inverted design eliminates expensive and messy drip pans

I-Beam Monorail Conveyors


Heavy Duty Capacity I-Beam Monorails handle the tough jobs for transporting and storing work in process.


- 3" and 4" track constructed from high strength carbon steel


